IMPORTANT DATES

January 14 2010: FLES orders must be postmarked by this date
Feb 15 - 26 2010: FLES test dates.
March 5: All answer sheets to arrive at scoring center in Kentucky.
March 15: List of students eligible to record speaking section will be sent to Chapter Administrator. Teachers will be informed immediately.
March 26: Last date to send tapes of students to national FLES administrator.

ORDERS

FLES kits contain material for up to 10 students. The CD is the same for all FLES students so you only need one per school unless you will be testing several classes simultaneously. Please read the division information carefully and select the appropriate divisions for your students. You are encouraged to enter entire sections.
