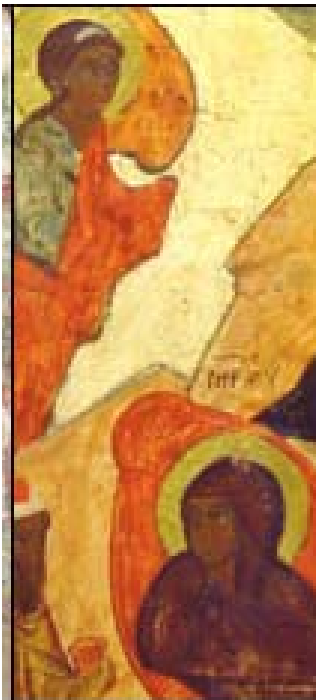


# Religion 3030A: Male, Female and Religion
