

Minor/Concentration Declaration Form

Students in all baccalaureate programs who wish to do so may add a minor to their major programs of study. The Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) degree programs require a minor. The courses to make up the minor should be planned with the major advisor, unless otherwise noted.

Within the fifteen hours of course work presented for the required minor in the B.A. programs, or the optional minor in any bachelor’s degree program, the student must have a minimum total institutional GPA of 2.0, with no more than three hours of “D” work. A minimum of nine of the fifteen hours must be earned at Georgia Southern University. A maximum of three hours may be taken under the S/U grading system within any minor.

Minors and second minors may be declared as early as the freshmen year but should always be declared as soon as possible so that students have adequate time to plan the completion of their minors. Minors may be declared by completing this form. A student changing his/her major may also declare or change a minor by completing the “Minors” section of the *Change of Major* form, which can be obtained in the Registrar’s Office or the student’s advisement center.

Instructions:

- 1) Secure your current advisor’s approval for the declaration of a minor or concentration.
- 2) Submit this form to the Registrar’s Office once this form has been completed by you and your advisor.
